Equine Sports Coach with at least 10 hours per month coaching	10	including mentoring and volunteering at ANWE club days	
Accredited Judge with Equine Breed Society or Equine sport	20	Current Judge qualifications or recognition with similar supportive equine sports e.g. Breed Society/Cattle sports/EA affiliated sports	
Complete a relevant online course	5	Any Online Courses based around the Horse or coaching Industry e.g. EA Drugs in sport or FEI Coaching – 5 points per course

Train a Consagrados / Grand Prix / Open status Campdraft	10	Must be the only rider/trainer since Competitor Preliminary WEQ/Official Novice Dressage/Maiden Campdraft must produce results	
Active Committee member of an ANWE club or sub-committee	15	Must be actively involved in administration or competition organisation Actively assisting in administration of ANWE Ltd – State/National committee member or sub-committee	
Actively Studying and/or presenting horse related courses	10	Study, complete and proof of a tertiary based relevant course. e.g. biomechanics or FEI coaching courses 10 points per course	
Currently competing at DEB W and above	15	Submit current horse name and competition records

<p>Pathway to initial accreditation</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Submit application to club for endorsement. • Submit Club endorsement to State Board for review. • Submit to National E & P committee for endorsement. • If accepted full Application with club, state, as well as the National E & P endorsement submitted to the National Board for approval. <p>Pathway for bi-annual review to be submitted by 1st July - approval path same as initial accreditation.</p> <p>*If due to medical/physical restrictions application for exemption of the compulsory Recognition of previous competition standards – DEB W and above will be considered with accompanying medical certificate.</p> <p>Any objections either by a person or club must be handled with accordance of the current rules and board directives.</p>
