5	FE	Free walk on long rein	Regularity, reach and ground cover with over track of free walk, allowing complete freedom to stretch the neck forward and downwards into light contact	2		
6	EH	Medium walk	Willing, calm transition, regularity, quality.			
7	Between H & C MB	Working trot Working trot	Willing, calm transition, regularity, quality, of trot.	2		
8	B BA	Circle right 20 metres Working trot	Regularity, shape and size of circle, bend and balance			
9	A X	Down centre line Halt through medium walk. Salute.	Bend and balance in turn; straightness; regularity of trot, willing, calm transition, straightness, attentiveness, immobility 3-5 seconds.
